

ANNUAL REPORT FOR FINANCIAL YEAR 2020-21

Operations Blessing India (OBI) is actively involved in a wide spectrum of projects oriented towards socially useful productive work. At the core of each project is the desire to enrich lives and bring hope where there is none. OBI works in the areas of Child Care & Education, Health and Medical Care, Clean Water & Sanitation, Disaster Relief and Community Development.

In 2020-21 OBI implemented at the grass root level in several areas of the nation. The categories of Humanitarian work were under Child Care & Education, Community Development & Livelihood, Clean Water and Health & Medical. OBI touched lives of over 90,132 beneficiaries through its programs.

Various Activities undertaken by the Company during the Financial Year 2020-21 is as follows:

A. CHILD CARE AND EDUCATION

OBI has its 12 School of Life Centers, supporting children in their education and guiding children back to the classroom, through its non-formal education programme, meals and awareness sessions.

School of Life Centers were run across 6 states across India, providing after school tuition for school going children in these slum areas and preparation for admission to mainstream government schools. Nutrition is a great need for children in this category and the children who attend the centers were provided nutritious meals in line with the mid-day meals provided by the State governments. The centers conducted awareness programs for children on preventive health and Extra-curricular activities for well-rounded child development. We were able to reach 1120 children with education and 9070 children were provided freshly cooked nutritious meals every day.



OBI runs a Vocational training Centre for blind students from under privileged families. Computer Lab program for Blind students has been setup in Delhi NCR with basic and advanced computer training, English coaching classes and Writer and Reader facilities for them to take competitive exams. This would help them to get jobs in government sectors viz. banks, railways and schools. We have been able to train

60 youth. This will also help them utilize the government reservation of 1% for visually Impaired & Blind youth.



Scholarship Program: The project aims at supporting students with poor economic background in completing their medical courses. A scholarship program was started to provide scholarships to needy students to pursue a medical course to set them up for their future and ensure that they achieve a skill which will give them a scope to have a secure job once they complete the course. 13 students were provided scholarship to pursue medical course.



B. COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

1069 women from the communities were provided training on beautician classes, tailoring and organic farming. 152 women were also provided education under the Adult Literacy Program. The focus was to empower the women from the communities to enable them to form Self Help Groups and earn a livelihood to support their family, especially children. The program was able to reach 780 beneficiaries.

C. HEALTH AND MEDICAL

OBI partnered with 3 hospital and has 4 PMTC's operating at the grass root level, reaching communities in villages or slums, with valuable experience in experience of running community clinics and conducting medical camps.

4 Community clinics providing basic health check-ups and referring those patients needing further treatment to the nearby hospitals reaching 10,730 beneficiaries were run 4 locations. The 3 Hospitals conducted 60 medical camps for cataract where 6,251 patients were screened. Health Awareness programs were carried out among communities reaching 1789 beneficiaries by all partner organizations.



D. LIFE CHANGING SURGERIES

OBI partnered with 4 hospitals who are working to serve the marginalized communities by conducting surgeries.

These Hospitals were:

1. Philadelphia Hospital Ambala, Haryana
2. Leprosy Mission Philadelphia Hospital, Salur, Andhra Pradesh
3. Velemegna Good News Society, Bidar, Karnataka
4. Padhar Hospital, Betul, Madhya Pradesh



These hospitals conducted 1,383 surgeries (1362 Cataract Surgeries, 21 Pediatric Cataract and Burn Contracture surgeries).



E. CLEAN WATER PROJECT

In March 2021, the Clean Water Project of **Operation Blessing India** launched its first pilot well with new protocol in place in Telangana. The **WASH** program was conducted at these locations which included an awareness session on simple methods of filtering water at home.

238 beneficiaries benefitted from the well.



F. DISASTER RELIEF

As Covid-19 spread its roots across the globe, India went into the lockdown by the end of March 2020 leaving the nation and its citizens helpless. As part of the COVID-19 interventions in India, OB carries out the following activities in the following locations. In addition to this Operation Blessing India also reached out to the people hit by the floods.

- ❖ Through the Community Kitchen we provided one daily meal to 26618 individuals including students at the School of Life Center and their families who have no income due to lockdown. The kitchen was operated by 10 women who were the mothers of these students.

- ❖ 37,981 Masks were distributed in the second-largest slum in Asia, at Faridabad. The masks were hand made by 10 women who learn stitching in the OB Community Development Center.
- ❖ Both the above initiatives provided livelihood with financial assistance to 28 women to supplement their family income during this period. We also associated with an NGO called MESH that works with Leprosy affected and handicapped groups made 3000 of these masks. (Note: leprosy colony workers are fully recovered from the disease but live-in colonies due to the high stigma attached to the disease traditionally).



- ❖ OBI extended its relief support in the flood effected areas in Antharvedipalem, East Godavari, Andhra Pradesh reaching 2700 beneficiaries. On assessing the situation, it was identified that the people in the area needed raw food materials. Hence, a relief kit was put together for 540 families which contained black gram, Toor dal (lentils), rice semolina, salt, sugar, tea leaves, oil and wheat flour. The relief kits benefited 2700 beneficiaries. Most of the families were quarantined due to the Covid-19 so the team distributed a few kits at their doorstep.
